Operations Analysis Report of MEIEA and MEISA cost of operations. Projections for 2009-10 show a potential net of approximately \$3,900. If MEISA associated activities were removed, MEIEA would show a potential net increase to about \$5,200. If MEISA were to operate independently without MEIEA support, it would fail to meet its financial needs by almost \$9,000.
